Minor traveling with one parent: The absent parent is expected to provide notarized consent. If only one parent has legal custody, that parent should be prepared to provide a court order of child custody to airlines and international authorities. A step father/mother cannot sign unless the child has been legally adopted.

Minor traveling alone: Both parents or the sole, documented custodial parent must provide notarized consent.

Minor traveling with a different surname: The parent should be prepared to provide evidence to airlines and official authorities, such a birth certificates or adoption decree, to prove that he or she is the parent.
