Health and Safety

We want to ensure your child a safe and positive environment during their time at camp. Campers are expected to abide by the camp rules and live by our core values. Final Payment

Final Payments are due in our office by May 15th. Any camper with a remaining balance will be prohibited from checking into camp. We do not accept final payments at camp. Cancellation Policy

In the event of a camper having to withdraw prior to the start of the session or any reason, a full camp credit of all camp tuition paid will be offered if the cancellation is up to five days before camp's start date. If the camper cancels within five days of the start of camp, regardless of reason, a camp credit will be given for the amount paid less \$100. The credit is transferable to another family member and is good through the 2018 season. There will be no credit offered for cancellations after the start of the camp session or for campers who leave camp early. Cash refunds are not offered.

CHECK-IN

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MEDIA RELEASE FORM

On behalf of the minor/child named below, in consideration for the minor/child's participation in the FogLax, LLC lacrosse instructional clinics and related activities, and for other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is herein acknowledged, I hereby grant the following rights and permissions to FogLax, LLC ("Photographer") and Photographer's legal representatives and assigns, those for whom Photographer is acting (including but not limited to FogLax, LLC, and its employees, officers, directors, shareholders, members, managers, successors, licensees, and affiliated entities, subsidiaries and assigns), and those acting with her authority and permission (together, the "Released Parties"). The Released Parties have the absolute right and permission to take, use, reuse, publish, republish, transmit and display photographic portraits or pictures, still or moving (with or without audio), of the minor or in which the minor may be included, in whole or in part, or composite or distorted in character or form, without restriction as to changes or alterations from time to time, in conjunction with the minor's own or a fictitious name, or reproductions of such images in color or otherwise, made through any medium at Photographer's studios or at the FogLax, LLC facilities, and in any and all media now or hereafter known, including the internet, for art, advertising, trade, publicity, or any other purpose whatsoever throughout the world. I specifically consent to the digital compositing or distortion of the images, including without restriction any changes or alterations as to color, size, shape, perspective, context, foreground or background. I waive any right that I or the minor may have to inspect or approve any finished product or products or the advertising copy or printed matter that may be used in connection with such photographs or the use to which it may be applied. I release, discharge, and agree to hold harmless and defend the Released Parties, Photographer, their legal representatives or assigns, and all persons acting under the Photographer's permission or authority or those for whom it is acting, from any liability by virtue of any reason in connection with the making and use of such images, including blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion, or use in composite form, whether intentional or otherwise, that may occur or be produced in the taking of said images or in any subsequent processing thereof, as well as any publication of them, including without limitation any claims for libel or violation of any right of publicity or privacy. I hereby warrant that I am a legal competent adult and a parent or legally appointed guardian of the minor, and that I have every right and the capacity to contract for the minor in the above regard. I state further that I have read the above authorization, release, and agreement, prior to its execution, and that I am fully familiar with the contents of it. This release shall be binding upon the minor and me, and our respective heirs, legal representatives, and assigns and shall run in perpetuity.

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RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

In consideration for being permitted to participate in the FogLax, LLC lacrosse instructional clinics and related activities, I (and on behalf of the below named minor child for whom I have the authority to bind to this agreement, hereinafter the "Releasees" or "we"), do hereby assume all risk of injury and release FogLax, LLC, its owners, members, employees, managers, agents and employees, licensees, and directors (the "Released Parties") from any and all liabilities, claims, injuries and damages (whether to person or property) arising out of participation in the FogLax, LLC lacrosse instructional clinics and related activities including but not limited to, losses, claims or liabilities caused by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties, other participants, or defects in the equipment, premises or facilities used.

Lacrosse is a contact, physical, and high-risk sport. We hereby represent and warrant that the minor child is in sufficiently good health to participate in all the lacrosse activities without risk to him/herself or others. The Releasees are cognizant of the risks and dangers inherent with the activities, that the minor child is fully capable of participating in the activities contracted for and the Releasees willingly, expressly, specifically and voluntarily assume the risk of injury as the Releasees' responsibility, including, risk of personal injury or property damage sustained while participating in the lacrosse instructional activities, including the risk of negligence by the Released Parties or the other participants.

We understand that we are required to provide all of the minor child's own safety equipment and have the responsibility for making sure that the equipment is in good repair, complies with all certification requirements, and has been maintained to the necessary standard to provide the maximum protection that the equipment is intended to provide. The Released Parties take no responsibility for the state of repair of the minor child's equipment nor have any obligation to inspect his/her equipment for fitness for this purpose. The Releasees must have the minimum level of equipment necessary to participate in the FogLax, LLC program, including but not limited to: helmet with chin strap and mouth guard; gloves; arm pads; chest pads; shoulder pads; an athletic supporter and cup; and whatever other equipment may be necessary.

In consideration of the minor being permitted to participate in the lacrosse instructional activities and use the facilities, the Releasees further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any and all claims which are brought by, or on behalf of, either myself or the minor child, and which are in any way connected with the FogLax, LLC program in any way whatsoever.

The Releasees specifically acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or any property is damaged as a result of the minor child's participation at the FogLax, LLC programs, the Releasees may be found to by a court of law to have waived their rights to maintain a lawsuit against the Released Parties on the basis of any claim from which the Releasees may have released the Released Parties from herein. Further, it is the express intention of the Releasees to waive all such rights to maintain any such suit against the Released Parties.

This contract shall be legally binding upon me, my heirs, my estate, assigns, legal guardians, and my personal representatives. I have carefully read the agreement and fully understand its contents. I am aware that I am releasing certain legal rights that I or the minor child otherwise may have and I enter into this contract in behalf of myself and the minor child and/or my family of my own free will.
