- We are looking forward to seeing you at camp this summer! Please read the enclosed information carefully. If you have any questions, please call us at 1-800-944-7112. This entire packet is downloadable at CampSquash.com under “Forms”.
- **Check-In-** All campers will check in at Lincoln Lobby in Charles Phelps Taft Hall and then proceed to John L. Vogelstein (JLV) dorm, on the first day of camp from 1:00-2:00pm; day & extended day campers should arrive at 2pm (there will be an afternoon & evening session of squash over at 8pm). These are air-conditioned dorms.
- **Camp Departure-** 12:00 pm on the last day of camp. Parents are invited to watch match play-offs & graduation that morning beginning at 9:30 am. The squash courts are located in the Donald F. McCullough Athletic Center.
- **Extended Day Campers-** After Sunday, you will arrive at the squash courts Monday-Friday at 8:45 am dressed to play. Pick-up will be at 8:30 pm at the dorm after the evening activities. Lunch and dinner is included. During breaks your central location will be the dorm lounge, so bring a deck of cards, game or book to stay engaged when not in an organized activity.
- **Day Campers** – After Sunday, you will arrive at the squash courts Monday-Friday at 8:45 am dressed to play. Pick-up will be at 5:00 pm at the squash courts. Lunch is included. During breaks your central location will be the dorm lounge, so bring a deck of cards, game or book to stay engaged when not in an organized activity.
- **Summer Camp Health Records** – IMPORTANT – All forms must be completed and signed by a physician. These forms must be brought to the camp at registration, not to be mailed in. Campers will not be admitted to camp without these forms. If you have medical questions please arrive early to speak our trainers. . If you have the most recent copy of your child’s immunization/physical form signed by a doctor you may staple this to OUR form. Please fill out the camper information & sign the waiver on OUR form to ensure the trainer has all the camp specific information we need
- **Medication-** If you plan to bring any inhaler, Epi-Pen or any over-the-counter medication to camp it must be accompanied by the Administration of Medication Form & the self administer portion signed. This form must be signed by the prescribing physician and parent.

- **Camp Phone-** You can leave a message for your camper by calling the camp office at 800-944-7112.
- Final Payments are due in our office by May 15th. If you have a balance and would like us to charge it to your credit card, please call us at 1-800-944-7112. Checks can be sent to 1700 Post Rd. Suite D-5, Fairfield CT 06824
- **Reminder of Cancellation Policy-** You may register for any camp with openings up to the start of camp. Payment by Credit Card or eCheck is required for all online, phone, mail or fax registrations. Any camper who must cancel, up to 6 days prior, to camp will receive a camp credit equal to the amount of camp tuition already paid. The credit is transferable to another family member and is good for any International Squash Academy through next summer (agreement begins at time of purchase). Any cancellation within 5 days of the start of camp will result in a camp credit minus \$300 cancellation fee. Camp credits are not extended to campers who leave camp after the start of a session. **CASH/CREDIT CARD REFUNDS ARE NOT OFFERED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.**
- **Cancellation Insurance-** We offer Cancellation Insurance for \$50 per session, payable when you register. This insurance entitles you to a full refund of camp fees paid if you cancel (for any reason) before June 1st. Please note: \$50 insurance fee is not refundable and can only be purchased at the time of registration. With Cancellation Insurance, if you cancel after June 1st, we will issue you a camp credit for all camp fees paid, good through the following year. This camp credit is transferable to anyone and may be used for any camp we run. Any cancellation within 5 days of the start of camp will result in a camp credit minus \$300 cancellation fee.

- **Key Deposit (OVERNIGHT CAMPERS ONLY)** – The school requires a key deposit of \$50 per camper. Please bring a check made out to “Taft School” for \$50. The check will be returned to the camper at the end of camp after they turn in their key.

From Boston (120 miles)

West via Massachusetts Turnpike to Sturbridge, Exit 9; west on Interstate 84 to Exit 20; north on Route 8 (3.9 miles) to Exit 37; Turn left at bottom of exit ramp (route 262 west) for 1.7 miles. At second light, turn right (still on 262). After approximately 2 miles, turn left at 2nd light onto Rt. 6 west. Taft is located on Route 6, on the right, after the third traffic light (a little more than a mile).

From Bradley International Airport (55 miles)

South via Interstate 91 to Hartford; west on Interstate 84 to Exit 20; north on Route 8 (3.9 miles) to Exit 37; Turn left at bottom of exit ramp (route 262 west) for 1.7 miles. At second light, turn right (still on 262). After approximately 2 miles, turn left at 2nd light onto Rt. 6 west. Taft is located on Route 6, on the right, after the third traffic light (a little more than a mile).

From New York City (90 miles)

North via Hutchinson River Parkway to White Plains; north on Interstate 684 to Exit 9 east; east on Interstate 84 to Southbury, Exit 15; At bottom of exit ramp, turn left onto Route 6 east to Watertown (12 miles from exit 15).

From Albany (105 miles)

East via NY State Thruway (I-90) which becomes Mass Pike. Exit at Exit 2, Head East on Rt. 20, then South on Rt. 8. At Exit 38 (Thomaston), go straight at the bottom of the exit ramp onto Rt. 6 West. Taft is on the right in approximately 7 minutes.

By Air, Train, Limo, or Bus

Bradley International Airport, near Hartford/Springfield, is 50 miles, an hour and five minutes from the school. Connecticut Limo (800-472-5466) runs regular service from Bradley, LaGuardia, and JFK airport
