Overnight Campers: Check in on Sunday (7/9 and 7/30) from 1:00pm-2:00pm at the dorm (TBA). Check out on Friday (last day) at 11:30am at the tennis courts.

Extended Day Campers: Check in on Sunday (7/9 and 7/30) from 1:00pm-2:00pm at the dorm (TBA). Check out on Friday (last day) at 11:30am at the tennis courts. Drop off Mon-Fri between 8:45am-9am. Pick up at 9pm each day except Friday at 11:30am.

Day Campers:

Week 1 (July 9-14) – 1:45pm-2:00pm on Sunday at the tennis courts. After the first day, campers should arrive daily between 8:45am-9:00am each day. Pick up is at 4:00pm daily except for Friday at 11:30am. Lunch is included.

Week 2 (July 17-21) – Mon-Fri 8:45am-9am check-in at the courts. Check out daily at 4pm. Lunch included

Week 3 (July 24-28) – Mon-Fri 8:45am-9am check-in at the courts. Check out daily at 4pm. Lunch included

Week 4 (July 30-August 4) – 1:45pm-2:00pm on Sunday at the tennis courts. After the first day, campers should arrive daily between 8:45am-9:00am each day. Pick up is at 4:00pm daily except for Friday at 11:30am. Lunch is included.

Health & Safety

We want to ensure your child a safe and positive environment during their time at camp. Drugs, alcohol and cigarettes are strictly forbidden, and will result in immediate dismissal from camp without a refund.

Overnight Key Deposit

The School requires a **key deposit of \$100** per camper. Please bring a check made out to "CT Tennis Camp" for \$100. The check will be returned to the camper at the end of camp after they turn in their key

Transportation

CT Tennis Camp is unable to provide transportation from airports, train stations or bus stops.

Cancellation Policy: Any camper who must cancel prior to camp will receive a camp credit equal to the amount of camp tuition already paid. The credit is transferable to another family member and is valid through next summer (agreement begins at time of purchase). Any cancelation within 5 days of the start of camp will result in a camp credit minus \$100 cancelation fee. Camp credits are not extended to campers who leave camp after the start of a session. CASH/CREDIT CARD REFUNDS ARE NOT OFFERED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.

Spending Money and other Valuables

It is not recommended that excessive amounts of cash be brought to camp. Please remind your camper to keep any spending money in a secure place. We also try to discourage campers from bringing electronic devices such as iPods and laptop computers. The CT Tennis Camp is not responsible for the theft or loss of personal items.

Directions to Fairfield University/CT Tennis Camp

FROM NEW YORK VIA CONNECTICUT TURNPIKE (I-95):

Take exit 22 in Connecticut - Round Hill Road. Continue straight through the stop sign at the end of the ramp. At the traffic light, take a left onto North Benson Road (Rt. 135) and continue straight for 0.8 miles (through two traffic lights.) The sign for the main entrance to Fairfield University will be on the left.

FROM HARTFORD OR VERMONT VIA I-91:

Take I-91 South to I-95 South in New Haven. Take exit 22 in Connecticut - North Benson Road. Turn right at the end of the ramp onto North Benson Rd. (Rte. 135). Go straight for 0.8 miles (through two traffic lights). The main entrance to Fairfield University will be on the left.

FROM NEW YORK VIA MERRITT PARKWAY (RT. 15):

Take exit 44. Turn left off the ramp, and turn right onto Black Rock Tpke. (Rt. 58) at the light. Proceed 2 miles to Stillson Rd. (Rt. 135) and turn right. Bear left, at the second light, onto North Benson Road. The University entrance will be on your right.

FROM HARTFORD AND NEW HAVEN VIA MERRITT PARKWAY (RT. 15):

Take exit 44, take a quick left off the ramp, then take another quick left onto Black Rock Tpke. (Rt. 58), proceed 2 miles to Stillson Rd. (Rt. 135) and turn right. Bear left, at the second light, onto North Benson Road. The University entrance will be on your right.

Agreement to Arbitrate Disputes

IN THE EVENT OF ANY DISPUTE PERTAINING TO ANY PROVISION OF THIS AGREEMENT, OR PERTAINING TO THE SERVICES RENDERED PURSUANT TO THIS AGREEMENT, OR IN ANY WAY RELATED TO ATTENDANCE AT THIS CAMP, INCLUDING ANY CLAIM FOR PERSONAL INJURY OR OTHER LOSS, INCLUDING ANY CLAIM AGAINST USSC, NIKE, INC., THE ENTITY OPERATING THE CAMP AND THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, OFFICIALS, AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES AND ALL SUBSIDIARIES, OWNERS, PARTNERS, JOINT VENTURERS, OFFICIALS, EMPLOYEES, OR AGENTS OF THE CAMP OR OF ANY FOREGOING ENTITY, EACH PARTY HERETO AGREES TO SUBMIT TO BINDING ARBITRATION TO RESOLVE SUCH DISPUTES, BY CLAIM FILED, BEFORE JAMS IN SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA, TO BE ARBITRATED HERE OR SUCH OTHER VENUE AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE JAMS ARBITRATOR, SUCH ARBITRATION TO PROCEED UNDER THE JAMS RULES. D) THE ARBITRATOR’S (S) AWARD IS NOT REQUIRED TO INCLUDE FACTUAL FINDINGS OR LEGAL REASONING AND ANY PARTY’S RIGHT TO APPEAL OR TO SEEK MODIFICATION OF RULINGS BY THE ARBITRATOR (S) IS STRICTLY LIMITED. CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS

BRING THIS FORM TO CAMP CHECK-IN. YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO CAMP WITHOUT THIS FORM. COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY BOTH CAMPER & PARENT/GUARDIAN.

We are looking forward to seeing you at camp! We know that you are attending a US Sports Camp to learn more about the sport you love. Please know that the safety of our campers is our #1 priority. So that there will be no misunderstandings and because **offenses will result in immediate dismissal without refund**, the following rules apply:

1. Campers are to remain on camp premises at all times and permission to leave must be obtained from the Director **ONLY**, provided you are properly signed out by a parent or guardian.
2. Campers are not permitted to leave the dorm after lights out. Once you are assigned a room, you are not allowed to change it without formal permission from the Director.
3. It is expected that campers will live together with mutual respect for one another and their property. It is forbidden to enter another student's room during his/her absence. Boys are not allowed in girls' rooms and girls are not allowed in boys' rooms. **Curfew, visitation, and quiet hours are strictly enforced.**
4. Abusive language, criticism, teasing, bullying, harassment or sarcasm is not tolerated. Campers will act in a courteous & respectful manner towards other campers, coaches, trainers, students, working personnel, and all other persons they may encounter on the host property.
5. Trespassing by campers into parts of the school buildings not specifically used by the Camp is forbidden. This includes, but is not limited to, kitchens, cellars, elevators, offices and all locked and unlocked rooms or closets.
6. Campers will not vandalize, deface, damage, or in any way misuse any host school property, camp property, or the property of other campers. Campers/Parents/Guardians will be charged for the cost of any repairs to dorm or other camp or campus property.
7. Flammables, explosives and firearms are not permitted at camp and tampering with electrical wiring, lighting, fire equipment or alarms is forbidden.
8. Possession or the use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages or drugs while at camp is forbidden. Camper bags may be inspected upon check in or at any time during camp to ensure no drugs, alcohol, or other improper substances are brought to camp.
9. Campers are not permitted to interact with Camp Director and/or staff through social media, email, text or phone before, during or after camp.
10. Full participation in the program is mandatory. Non-participation for ANY reason, including illness or injury, does NOT qualify for a tuition refund.
11. The Camp **IS NOT** responsible for lost or stolen articles or money. Please leave valuables at home.
12. Cell phone usage is prohibited during camp activities. Cell phones must be kept in the dorm room and can only be used there (not in the gym, court, cafeteria, etc.). Though allowed, cell phones are not required. Should the need arise, the Camp Director and/or staff will have a phone available for camper's use or to directly contact the camper's parent/guardian.

In the event of a violation of Camp Policy, Parents/Guardians will be immediately notified and required to pick up and/or arrange for transportation home for the camper(s) involved.
